Historic Road Sports; Drivers' Meeting
Sunday 16th October – 12 Noon

MINUTES

- 1) Many drivers have voiced their disappointment about today's race schedule. Whilst it is understood that every Championship must take its turn to be last race of the day, it does not seem sensible for races that are double headers to have both of their races before a race that only has one race of the day. At one stage we were in threat of only getting an 11-minute race. Fortunately, the club/organisers did a super job and turned this around so that we did get a twenty-minute race. However, it could have been very different. **Action: on Kevin to raise at main Board level.**
- 2) We have had paddock lay out issues most of the year with the paddock plan not being adhered to, Croft being the worst when the HRS area was completely taken up by trailers and Caravans of the spectators. It was felt that this not only frustrating, but also leads to the drivers being separated in the paddock and therefore not encouraging the camaraderie that we would all like to see. **Action: Kevin to raise at the Board to see if we can get the main club to have feet on the street policing the paddock.**
- 3) Many drivers said that they would like a race at the Silverstone Classic, the entry cost of £1000 was mentioned and still 16 drivers said that they would want to do this. **Action: on Kevin to talk to Charles Barter in 70's to see if they have a similar appetite and could we put on a combined grid. – This may be too late for 2017, but Kevin to investigate.**
- 4) We also spoke of a race abroad as part of the Championship, the circuits of Spa, Pau, Dijon, Zandvoort, Croix en Ternois and Val de Vienne being mentioned. If we are to do this in 2017 as a pilot, then we would amend the rules to say that two rounds are to be dropped from the annual drivers' points. 17 drivers voted to say that they would enter a foreign round. It was agreed that we would not wish to do Silverstone Classic and a race abroad in the same year. **Kevin should investigate the best potential.**
- 5) We spoke around how do we encourage new entries with the ideas of adding an FiA class for GT cars (not GTS or GTP) and/or reviewing our current regulations towards the "Improved Road Sports" interpretation. **Action: on Kevin to review with all class reps to analyse the potential for this.**
- 6) It was agreed that we will allow the use of Yokohama tyres that do not have an "E" mark as an approved tyre, subject to a road legal tread depth. **Action on Kevin to define in the 2017 regulations**
- 7) A vote was taken for dry sumps and it was agreed that we do not want to allow them.
